UPDATE ON KENTISH TOWN WASTE FOOD THEFT

Iceland is pleased that the Crown Prosecution Service has taken note our representations today in deciding that it would not be in the public interest to pursue the prosecution of three individuals charged with the theft of waste food from bins in a secure storage yard behind the Iceland store in Kentish Town, London.

The store in question is next door to a police station. Iceland staff did not call the police, who attended on their own initiative. Nor did we instigate the resulting prosecution, of which we had no knowledge until the media reports of it appeared yesterday evening.
